









# **Crime Fiction Reads**



She specifically mentioned being a fan of John Grisham, John Sandford, David Baldacci, Vince Flynn, Michael Connelly, S.J. Parris, C.J. Box, and Robert Crais and liking having a character to follow in multiple books. Because of her wide range of favorite authors, I included a range of mysteries, including contemporary hardboiled, legal thrillers, and historical mysteries. This is a 2-page list.

#### **Police Procedurals**

- Stephen J. Cannell's Shane Scully series. Gritty, realistic police procedural about an LAPD detective. Recommended for David Baldacci fans.
- Tony Hillerman's Jim Chee and Joe Leaphorn series. Authentic police procedurals set on the Navajo Reservation and featuring tribal policemen. Recommended for C.J. Box fans.
- Craig Johnson's Walt Longmire series. Gritty, colorful procedurals focused on a contemporary Wyoming sheriff. Recommended for C.J. Box fans.

### **Private Investigators**

- James Lee Burke's Dave Robicheaux series. Dark, gritty mysteries about a private investigator in Southern Louisiana. Recommended for John Sandford fans.
- Robert B. Parker's work. Engaging, fast-paced mysteries with vivid settings and violent crimes,
  recommended for Robert Crais fans. His Spenser series follows a tough, funny private investigator in
  Boston in the style of hardboiled noir detectives investigating modern crimes. Not PI specific but in a
  similar vein is the Jesse Stone series about a former LAPD cop who now works as the police chief of a
  small Massachusetts town.



## Suspense/Thrillers

- Lee Child's Jack Reacher series. Violent, action-packed books about a former military MP who now wanders around the country, sorting out trouble wherever he arrives. Recommended for fans of Michael Connelly and David Baldacci.
- James Patterson's work. Recommended for fans of John Sandford and C.J. Box. His Alex Cross series are gritty psychological thrillers about a D.C.-based profiler investigating a range of crimes. His Michael Bennet series is fast-paced suspense about an NYPD detective.
- Daniel Silva's Gabriel Allon series. Action-packed espionage thrillers about a Mossad agent. Recommended for David Baldacci fans.

# **Legal Thrillers**

• William Bernhardt's Ben Kincaid series. Suggested for John Grisham and Michael Connelly fans. Bernhardt blends contemporary issues into these fast-paced legal thrillers about a Tulsa-based defense attorney.

### **Historical Mysteries**

 Ariana Franklin's Adelia Aguilar series. Follows the adventures of an Italian woman medical examiner in the medieval period. Combines rich historical details with readable plots and complex characters.
 Recommended for S.J. Parris fans.
